Pre-Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) Injection Guidelines

Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP), which is injected into the site of injury, is blood plasma with concentrated platelets. The concentrated platelets found in PRP contain growth factors that are vital to initiate and accelerate tissue repair and regeneration. These proteins initiate connective tissue healing and repair, promote development of new blood vessels, and stimulate the healing process.

Please note that PRP procedure is a self-pay only procedure and not covered by insurance. The fee is \$1500.00 (subject to change) and is due on the day of service.

Appointment Information

When you arrive, please check in at Patient Access to register and make your payment.

Please note:

- No corticosteroids for 2 weeks before the procedure.
- Discontinue non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDS) and Aspirin 1 week (7 days) before your procedure.
- Do not take anti-coagulation (blood thinners) 5 days before the procedure.
- Increase your fluid intake in the 24 hours before your procedure.
- You must arrange for a ride home from the hospital.
