Financial Assistance Eligibility Policy Summary

New England Baptist Hospital's promise to the community is to help people who cannot pay their New England Baptist Hospital bills and qualify under the Financial Assistance Eligibility Policy.

WHO CAN APPLY

All people are able to apply for financial help. This Policy provides free care or discounted fees for those who have:

- No insurance
- Ruled out all other payment options
- Income compared to the current year's Federal Poverty Guidelines(FPG) see chart below to determine qualification of free care or discounted fees not to exceed Amounts Generally Billed (AGB) to people with insurance.
- Income over 300% may also be eligible for assistance through NEBH not to exceed AGB.

Financial Counselors will work with people who do not have insurance. They will help fill out paperwork for Medicaid, Health Connector (including ConnectorCare), Health Safety Net, the Children's Medical Security Program, and Medical Hardship.

They can also help people sign up for coverage through the Health Insurance Exchange.
